Subject: Constitution of the Steering Committee on "Geo-spatial Chairs".

Department of Science & Technology, Government of India, has created Geospatial Chairs Professors at number of institution/universities as part of Natural Resources Data Management System (NRDMS) Programme to promote geo-spatial technologies and their applications. In supersession of all the earlier Committees set up at the different places to monitor the progress of Chairs, it has been decided to constitute a Steering Committee on Geo-spatial Chairs to review, guide, monitor the progress of the Chair Professors and suggest mid-course corrections and also finalise annual action plans, future strategies and their continuation beyond approved tenures.

Terms of Reference: B.

- 1. The Steering Committee shall guide, monitor the progress of the Chair Professors and suggest mid-course corrections and also finalise annual action plans, future strategies and their continuation beyond approved tenure;
- 2. The Steering Committee shall also suggest the new areas of research and emerging technologies to be followed by these Geo-spatial Chair Professors;
- 3. The Steering Committee may co-opt any other member, as and when required.
- 4. Selection of Geo-spatial Chair Professors/continuations will be made based on the recommendations of the Steering Committee.
- Tenure: Tenure of the Steering Committee will be for a period of three years from C. the date of its first meeting.

Payments of TA/DA D.

The non-official members of the Steering Committee shall be paid TA (Economy Class) and honorarium as per the rules of Government of India for attending the meetings of the Committee.
