**75<sup>th</sup> Lindau Nobel Laureate Meeting 2026**

Lindau Foundation, Germany has been organizing the meeting with Nobel laureates in Physics, Chemistry and Medicine to discuss the major issues of importance in these fields, since 1951. The meeting includes lectures, round tables and interactive sessions among the young students and the scientists. Department of Science & Technology (DST), Govt. of India has been supporting the participation of meritorious Indian students at Masters, Doctoral and Post-Doctoral levels to interact with Nobel Laureates and other scientists to shape up their future research careers. DST has so far deputed over 549 young researchers in the age group of 20-30 years to the meeting of Nobel Laureates and Students in Lindau Germany.

This year, about 40 Nobel Laureates in the area of Physics have confirmed to attend the Lindau Meeting and interact with young scientists which is scheduled during 28th June to 3rd July 2026. For the participation of Indian students in the 75<sup>th</sup> Lindau Nobel Laureate Meeting 2026 in the area of Interdisciplinary Sciences, Department of Science and Technology (DST) had received 355 eligible applications, out of which 11 candidates have been jointly selected by the Lindau Foundation and DST.
