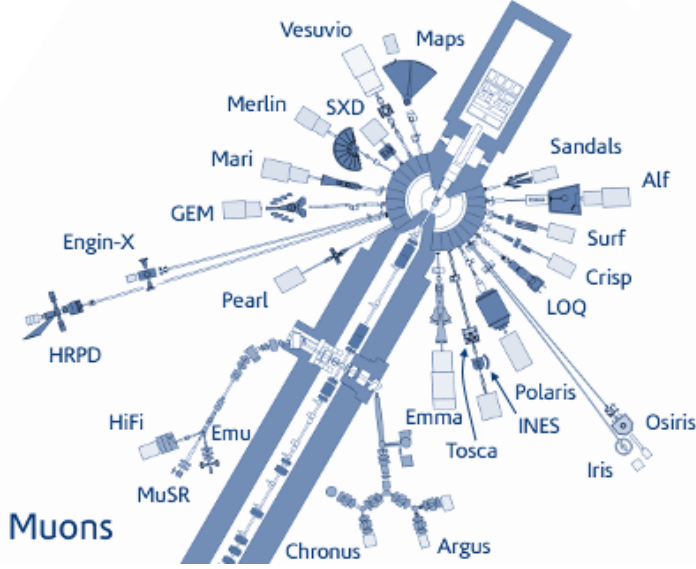
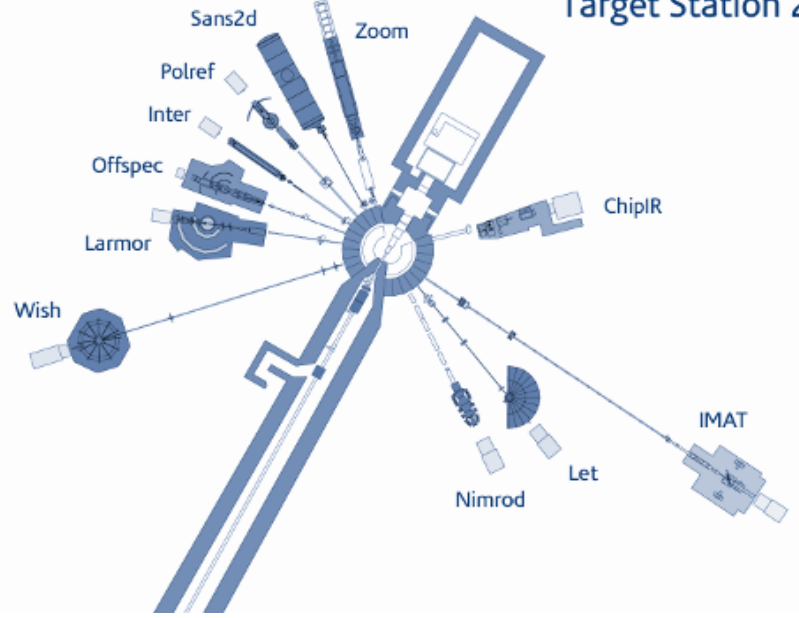


## Indian Access to Neutron and Muon Experimental Facilities at ISIS Rutherford Appleton Laboratory is Open Now

The Nanomission program of the Department of Science and Technology, through Jawaharlal Nehru Centre for Advanced Scientific Research (JNCASR), has signed an agreement with the Science and Technology Facilities Council (STFC), United Kingdom, to facilitate collaboration between scientists from the United Kingdom and India in neutron scattering and muon spectroscopy using the experimental facilities at ISIS Rutherford Appleton Laboratory (RAL) for nanotechnology and advanced materials research.
