

## Scheme for Young Scientists and Technologists

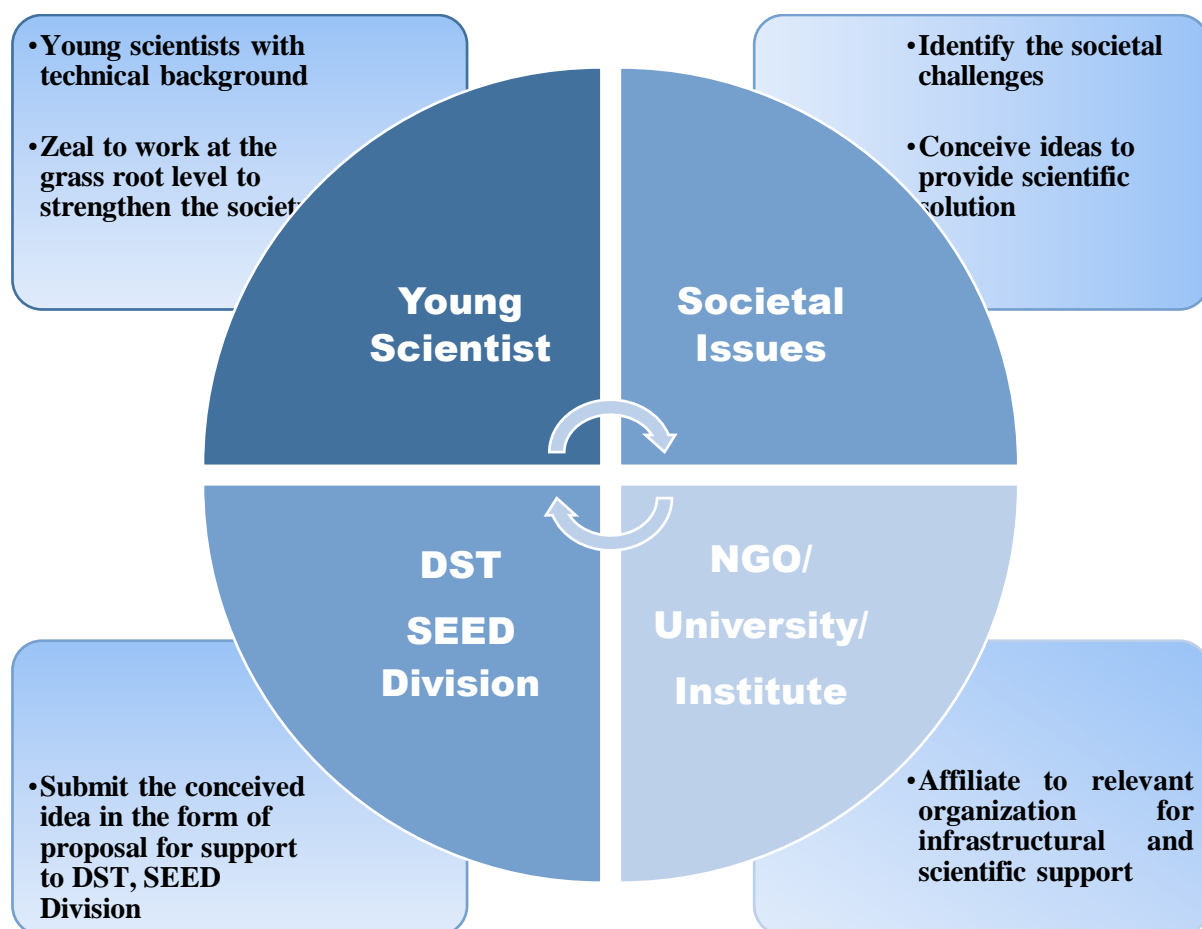
Scheme for Young Scientists and Technologists (SYST), was evolved in 1992 with a vision to encourage young scientists to identify social challenges and provide S&T based solutions using lab-to-land approach. The scheme was revamped, rejuvenated and reenergized in 2014, to inspire young S&T professionals to present ideas of social relevance.

### Objectives of the Scheme:

1. To encourage young scientists and technologists who have a zeal to work with the society to provide scientific solution to the existing/futuristic problems.
2. To foster innovative ideas having direct bearing on society, as well as visible technology transfer component.

### Eligibility:

1. M.Sc./PhD in any stream of Science and Technology.
2. Age 35 years. Relaxation of 5 years for Women and Differently-abled (Divyangjan) applicants and those belonging to SC/ST/OBC category.



Under SYST, DST invites proposals through *Call for proposals* every year in February-March.
