



Scoping Report on Environmental Sensors in India and the UK

Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India and UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) are inviting proposals to deliver a scoping exercise to identify emerging research priorities in the area of low-cost environmental pollution sensor development and use.

Effective monitoring and management of environmental pollutants associated with rapid economic growth and modern societies is a major global challenge. Of particular importance in addressing this issue is access for decision-makers to adequate data on the presence, quantity and behaviour of pollutants in the environment so as to better understand their impacts at a local and national level and inform suitable management approaches. As part of their collaborative strategy-setting, DST and UKRI wish to commission a team to undertake a mapping report on this topic with specific reference to India and the UK and are inviting tenders to submit their detailed proposals.
